

Nairn County FC Health & Safety Policy

Policy Intent

The Club seeks to provide a safe and healthy environment for all personnel, sub-contractors and the general public.

Policy Implementation

- Provide adequate control of the health and safety risks arising from all work activities.
- Consult on a regular basis with club employees and voluntary personnel on any matters affecting their health and safety.
- Provide and maintain safe premises, plant and equipment.
- Ensure safe handling and use of substances.
- Provide relevant information, instruction and supervision for all employees and voluntary personnel.
- Ensure all employees and voluntary personnel are competent to complete their tasks by provision of adequate training.
- Seek to provent accidents and cases of work-related ill health.
- Maintain a safe and healthy work environment.
- Review and revise this policy on an annual basis.
- Fire log to be completed weekly.
- Evacuation protocol match day to be completed on each home game and filed in Fire Log.

Safety Objectives

Nairn County Football Club places great emphasis on Health and Safety and the environmental aspects of operating the Football Club. We therefore strive to:

- Fully observe all HSE legislation and regulations.
- Maintain the standards set out regarding safety of sports grounds.
- Continually review and improve upon our safe working practices.
- Support all personnel acting for or on behalf of the Club in providing a safe environment for spectators and visitors to the park.
